

Aquatics Summer 2026 recap

Lap Swim: 287 pass holders made 1651 visits, and we sold 3,010 drop-in units.

Water Exercise: 160 pass holders made 1309 visits, and we sold 877 drop-in units.

Adult Water Polo: 46 pass holders made 176 visits, and we sold 235 drop-in units.

Family Swim Pass: Sold 109 passes, 2826 pool entries

Rec Swim: 15,696 drop-in swimmers

Aquatics Staff Weekly Training: During the summer season, aquatic staff participate in weekly in-service trainings held Fridays from 9:00 –11:00 a.m. at Robert Livermore Aquatic Center, with the exception of June 26 at May Nissen Aquatic Center and no training on July 3.

July 4 Pool Party: 667 Livermore residents, 122 non-residents \

Electric Eels: 255 Swimmers registered. The Eels trained at LHS and held meets at RLAC and completed two home meets at RLCC (June 5 and 12) with 300+ swimmers at each event. RLCC hosted the Valley Swim League Champs Meet, July 18. Eels finished 2nd overall.

Livermore Aqua Cowboys (LAC): LAC continues to use both facilities for its year-round team and brings in an average of 300 participants ages 6 - 70+. On May 15, we hosted its block party and potluck, which also served as a mock swim meet to help

new swimmers experience meet protocol. September 19-20 RLCC will host their season opener USA Swimming Meet with 400+ swimmers.
