4. Update on the Pickleball Recycling Pilot Program: The Tri-Valley Pickleball Club provided a three-month update on the Pickleball Recycling Pilot Program.

➤ **Action:** The Facilities Committee approved adding another pickleball recycling bin at May Nissen Park. The Tri-Valley Pickleball Club will provide a quarterly update at a future committee meeting.

5. **Follow-Up on the Avenza Maps Mobile App:** RM Benjamin provided a follow-up update on the Avenza Maps mobile app, including subscription tiers and app usage.
 - **Action:** The Committee directed staff to move forward with the Avenza Maps mobile app and include the trails at Sycamore Grove and Holdener parks.
6. **Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Update / CIP Project List (Standing Item):** PFM Haldeman and PCM Weisgerber provided an update on current CIP projects as of July 21, 2026. Detailed project updates were included in the Facilities Committee agenda packet.
 - **Action:** No Committee action was taken. This was an informational update and discussion only; however GM Fuzie and PFM Haldeman will meet to determine which LARPD-owned playgrounds will be prioritized for future replacement.
