
# GREAT SUMMER OVERALL!

- Enrollment is increasing at our sites (23% increase from last year)
- Over 6500 registrations in camps and ESS
- 82 Youth volunteers, 3242 volunteer hours




OPEN HEART KITCHEN PROGRAM MOVED BACK INSIDE, MODIFIED FOR BOXED LUNCH OPTION

- Sports programs served over 2180 kids over a 9-week period
- New programs added, including: 3 additional dance camps and Around the World Craft camp
- Parent feedback was very positive, and programs continue to grow




# AQUATICS

- 40% Increase in swim lessons, held primarily at May Nissen pool
- Over 55 staff working between both RLAC and May Nissen pools, both guarding and teaching swim lessons
- Lifeguard Games
- Friday Night Swim brought back, very popular

### NATURE CAMPS

- Ran 7 weeks this summer with an average of 80 kids/week
- Changes made, such as making programs more affordable, placing kids in groups of 12 by age and utilizing more Rangers in programs
- Addition of a Counselor-in-Training program
- Many returning staff assumed leadership roles

Resumed operation of the RLCC Café after 2-year hiatus
